Release Update

2.31 to 2.33

One quick release was put on the web after 2.31 (namely 2.32) in order to fix bugs that had crept into the system and made it awkward to install. They are not listed here as they did not affect the program after a successful installation was done.

Below is a list of the changes that have been introduced since 2.31

- 1 A practice plan has been added to the system where scheduled practices and existing drills can be combined to create a comprehensive practice plan. This plan can then be printed and then (like all reports) emailed to coaches and players so that everybody knows what is supposed to happen during a practice and minimal ice time is wasted on explanations.
- 2 The bug that caused the system to crash when a report was emailed has been corrected.
- 3 A What's on Where? Web page has been added. This is a schedule of games at selected Venues irrespective of divisions and skill levels and it is nice addition to your web site for people who want to watch some local hockey.
- 4 The volunteer list can now be printed in division sequence. If this sequence is chosen and a volunteer has more than one child currently registered an * will print after the division description and the volunteer will appear on the different division pages. (2 *'s for 2 kids and 3 for 3 etc). If the volunteer has no kids registered they are classed as "unconnected"
- 5 An individual player export capability has been added to the system so that player information in the form of a CSV file can be sent to the “sub databases” when late registrations occur. The selection of the desired players follows the same procedure as the Player Search utility. The file can be saved or emailed to existing personnel in the database in the same manner as you would email a report. The Import program has also been amended to allow the very simple import of this Heycoach!! generated file.
- 6 A deposit date has been added to the registration program so that PD cheques can be marked and the Registration report has been altered so the Deposit analysis can be sorted on either the registration date or the PD cheque date. At the moment there is only one cheque date but we are looking into tracking multiple PD cheques.
- 7 We have expanded the web transfer capabilities a bit so the existing web pages or PDF files that have been created outside of Heycoach!! can now also be sent to your website. (e.g. a latest news page or AGM minutes). The file to be transferred must reside the “webpages” subdirectory.

- 8 The Referee payslips/game costs report has been improved. The costs can be reported now on either scheduled officials for a game or the actual officials. When using the actual officials the system will only report on the officials who were entered in the game sheet capture (e.g. referees and linesmen) and not on other types of paid officials (e.g. gatekeepers and timekeepers). The actual officials selection in hockey also has the ability to pay two of the officials as referees.
